Notice To Farmers And Riparian Owners - 2009 Schedule of works

The Board's contractors will require access to The Board's Viewed Rhynes to carry out routine maintenance/weed cutting during the following months. The works (under Section 15 of The Land Drainage Act 1991) will take place in accordance with the following programme. Flailing of banks may be necessary and may be carried out up to two weeks prior to weed cutting. Riparian owners are reminded that a NINE METRE maintenance strip from the top of the bank must be kept clear for access. Whilst all efforts are made to minimise damage to crops it is not possible to interrupt or delay the programme to avoid harvesting operations as efficient routes for the weed cutting have been established.
