Notice To Farmers And Riparian Owners - 2009 Schedule of works

The Board's contractors will require access to The Board's Viewed Rhynes (under Sections 14 & 15 of The Land Drainage Act 1991) to carry out routine maintenance/weed-cutting during the following months. The works will take place in accordance with the following programme. Flailing of banks maybe necessary and this may be up to two weeks prior to weed cutting. Riparian owners are reminded that a NINE METRE maintenance strip from the top of the bank must be kept clear for access. Whilst all efforts are made to minimise damage to crops it is not possible to interrupt or delay the programme to avoid harvesting operations as efficient routes for the weed cutting have been established
